

# THE DOCK OF THE BAY

## OTIS REDDING

### Biografi:

Født 9. september 1941 i Dawson, Ohio – død 10. december 1967.

Reddings far var baptistpræst, så gospelmusikken var en integreret del af hans hverdag. Men han blev efterhånden også interesseret i 'jump blues' og R&B. En væsentlig grund hertil var nok, at familien var flyttet til byen Macon, der var et kraftcenter inden for blues og R&B, bl.a. fordi 2 så prominente kunstnere som Little Richard og James Brown boede der. Han optrådte hyppigt ved talentkonkurrencer med kopiversioner af Little Richard- og Elvis Presley-numre. I 1960 var han på familiebesøg i Los Angeles, og det var her, han lavede sin første indspilning "She's all right". Med sin egen sang "These arms of mine", der blev indspillet i 1963 og udgivet på Stax/Volt, begyndte der for alvor at ske noget. Redding befandt sig godt med musikerne på Stax; han indspillede og producerede sine egne ting og arrangerede og producerede for andre i et tæt samarbejde med bl.a. Steve Cropper, Booker T. og Isaac Hayes. 1967 var det helt store år. Dels med indspilningen af pladerne "Otis Redding in Person at the Whiskey a go go" og "Good to me", og dels som hovednavn på Stax-Volt tourneen til Europa. Hovedbegivenheden var dog hans optræden sammen med Jimi Hendrix på Monterey International Pop Festival. Men 1967 blev også hans skæbneår. Den 10. december forulykkede hans og hans bands fly, og alle blev dræbt. Kun 3 dage forinden havde de indspillet det, der skulle blive Reddings største succes: "Sittin' on the Dock of the Bay", der ikke kun toppede på de 'sorte' R&B-lister, men også nåede helt til tops på den 'hvide' top 40-liste.
